


A 2007 deed describes a 0.6508-acre tract occupied by a grave site. However, above-ground evidence of burials appears to occupy a larger area of almost 1.5 acres.

Detail Map (right) depicts the approximate area with above-ground evidence of burials. Perimeter is defined by cyclone fencing on the eastern and northernmost boundary, while the southern and western boundary roughly follows an old dirt road and foot path.

Exact historic boundary is not known.
